There are two ways to register for the upcoming season.

1: BY MAIL

1. Complete the enclosed Player Registration Form for each child to be registered.
2. Please verify that all information is correct and current.
 - a. ***Income Tax receipts will be distributed by email – a valid email address is required.***
3. Fill out the Fee Section on the registration form. For families registering more than one player, please complete the Fee Section on only one player's form.
4. Payment options:
 - a. Make cheques payable to **RMHC**, (total registration amount can be split over three cheques dated no later than Nov. 1, 2010.)

NOTE: Should you have a player trying out for a district AAA team or the RHS Royals team, please submit only 1 cheque dated for Nov. 1, 2010.
 - b. Write your Visa or MasterCard number, along with Expiry Date, in the payment section at the bottom of the Registration Form

2: IN-PERSON

This registration is for all of the Riverview Parks and Recreation fall programs. Bring your registration forms with you and look for the RMHC table in the canteen area. Payment is required at time of registration. Cash, debit, cheque(s), or credit card (Visa or MasterCard) will be accepted.

Second player discount - \$25 discount available to families who have two players registering in the novice and above divisions. *(Not applicable to two player families where one of the players is in Initiation).*

Family Rate – \$915 for families of 3 or more players.

Competitive Try-Outs:

The try-out fee is \$45 per player. **Players in PeeWee and above must attend a checking clinic if they did not play contact hockey last season.**

Female Hockey

Circle Yes on the registration form if you wish to play exclusively on an all female team in the atom to midget divisions.

Late Registration

Any registrations received after September 11, 2010 are subject to a \$75 administration fee per player and will only be accepted contingent upon number of players registered in the corresponding division.

Non-Payment Policy

Registrations fees must be paid in full no later than November 1, 2010. Should collection efforts fail to yield payment by November 15, 2010 there will be an immediate suspension of Club membership privileges until such time as payment is received in full.
